## **According to Your Faith**

As Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, calling out, "Have mercy on us, Son of David!" When he had gone indoors, the blind men came to him, and he asked them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" "Yes, Lord," they replied. Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your faith let it be done to you;" and their sight was restored. Jesus warned them sternly, "See that no one knows about this." But they went out and spread the news about him all over that region. Matthew 9:27-31

Although the crowd was moving in on Him, Jesus recognized her touch was different. She was healed immediately, and He said to her, "Daughter your faith has made you whole."

Child of God, all you need is one touch from God to turn your situation around. Don't you realize that the God we serve is Almighty, Undefeatable, All Powerful, and One who is able to do exceedingly and abundantly, above all you could ever think or ask? Then why would you ever doubt Him? As a Good Father, He only wants the best for His children. So, be assured that if you did not receive whatever was requested, it wasn't good for you.
